



Removable laparoscopic vertical gastroplasty clip for weight loss




BARICLIP

Description:

The BARICLIP® is a laparoscopically implanted, silicone covered titanium device with a low closing pressure placed vertically around the stomach parallel to the lesser curvature of the stomach, and separates the stomach into a restricted medial segment where food would pass and an excluded larger lateral gastric segment (Fig.1). The device restricts the amount of food consumption in severely obese patients (Body Mass Index (BMI) of at least 35 kg/m2, or a BMI between 30 kg/m2 and 50 kg/m2 with one or more obesity related comorbid conditions)

without the need for cutting, stapling, bypassing of the stomach or the intestines, or device adjustment. It is indicated for use only in adult patients of age between 18 and 65 years.


